WHAT TO EXPECT IN PREPARING FOR YOUR SURGERY

Improving your health prior to surgery provides a safer and more successful surgical experience.

Based on your current health and the type of surgery you are having, you may need a phone interview or an in-person medical assessment.

Phone Interview - within 5-7 days before your surgery

A registered nurse (RN) from our department will contact you to review your medical history and current medications.

Based on the phone interview, it may be necessary for you to come to our clinic for further assessment.

In-person Medical Assessment - The Prepare team will reach out to you within 24 hours to schedule this visit prior to your surgery

You will meet with a doctor or advanced practice clinician. Our clinician will:

- Review your medical history
- Perform a physical exam
- Identify health issues
- Keep your primary provider informed as we partner with you through this process

The Surgery Prepare Team will work with you to set up a plan to address any health issues that may have been identified in order to reduce your surgical risk and prepare you for the best surgical outcomes.
